





Storytelling Workshop Instructions (Facilitated)

Welcome:

- Introduce yourself and Storytelling Connects. Say:
 - o We are going to create a story together using a series of picture cards
 - This will be fun and we'll use our imaginations to work together to create our story
- Ask the participants to introduce themselves

Creating the story:

| ١. | Place the cards face down in a random order, e.g. | | | | | | |
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(Depending on the level of the group: use 4-9 cards; this can be done as a group (no more than 6), in pairs or individually)

- 2. Invite the group participants to pick a card to turn over
- 3. Ask the participants questions to encourage them to talk about the image
- 4. Focus on: People, Place, Plot, Emotion and Sound/Music
- 5. Write down on the back of the image what the participants say stick this to the back of the image once finished
- 6. Read the story they have created
- 7. Place the card face down
- 8. Repeat with the other cards
- 9. Invite the group to rearrange the images into the story they would like to tell
- 10. In the final round, pick up each image and read the story to the group. Or invite a member of the group to read the story back (remember to write clearly). Hold up the picture so the whole group can see it.
- II. Where possible include some music in the retelling via Spotify or YouTube or invite the group to sing the tune
- 12. Thank everyone for their input and creativity

Presenting the story:

- After the session, you can write up the story and send it back to the group/individuals
- One way to do this is to provide a PowerPoint with a recording of the story and inserts of the music.

How to encourage the story:

- Can you tell me what you see?
- What do you think is happening?
- Where are they/he/she?
- Can you tell me about the person/people in this picture?

Story Builder







- Shall we give them a name?
- What age are they?
- What do you think they are feeling?
- Are there any sounds that you want to be part of this story?
- What music do you think would go with this picture?
- Is there anything else you would like to say about this picture?

After the first card:

- Is this the same person/s?
- What can we say is happening now?
- And repeat as above...

Changing the order:

- Would you like to change the order of the story?
- How would the story sound if we moved the cards?
- Would anyone like to read out one of the stories?
